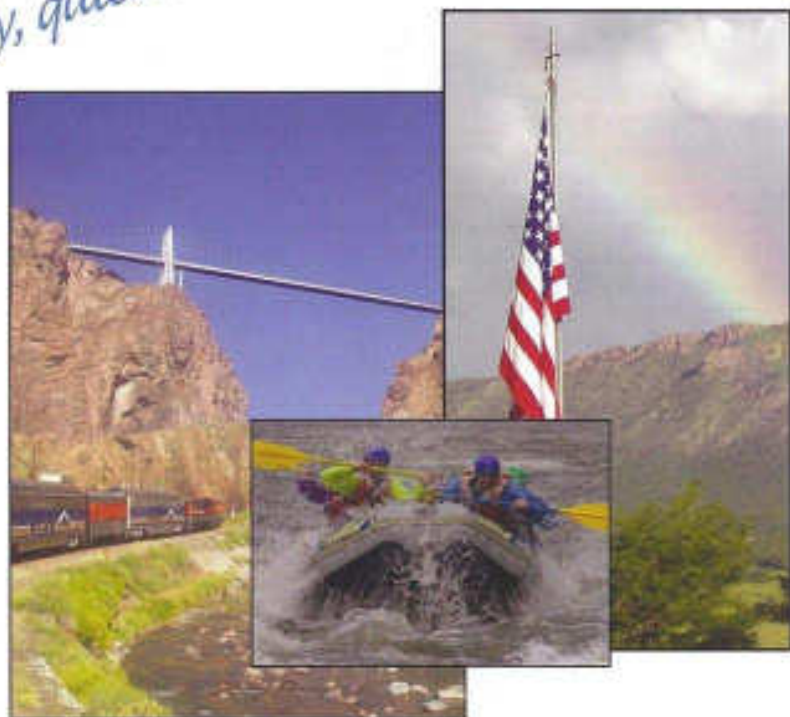

So Much To See & Do

Gold Belt Tour Drive

Drive the Gold Belt Tour and retrace the historic travel routes connecting Cripple Creek and Victor Mining District, site of the world's largest gold rush, to the communities of Florence, Cañon City and Florissant.

Phantom Canyon Road, a dirt road that follows the path of what was once the busiest narrow gauge railroad in the West.

Shelf Road, a dirt road blasted out of the steep side walls of Fourmile Canyon, carried stagecoaches and freight wagons from the Arkansas Valley to the mining camps.

High Park Road, paved road used by ranchers and prospectors, first route connecting the gold fields to the Arkansas Valley.

Teller One, paved road connecting the Mining District to the Colorado Midland Railroad at Florissant on to Pikes Peak.

Services may be limited in some cases so remember to be prepared, drive safely and take your time, you are on vacation and there are many things you may miss by being in a rush. We want you to enjoy yourselves and continue to come back and explore our backyard. Colorado is beautiful please help to keep it that way on your travels.

Guidelines & Policies

Thank you for choosing Royal View @ Royal Gorge Campground. We understand you have a choice in your travel arrangements and appreciate you choosing Royal View Campground. For your enjoyment and safety we ask that you read and follow our Park policies. Remember that you are not the only one here for a good time. We are a family campground and want to maintain a "Rated G" environment. Profanity, loud, offensive or disorderly conduct will not be tolerated.

- **Quiet Hours:** From 10:00 PM to 7:00 AM. No outside speakers, car radios or loud music at any time. Please respect other guests and remember that sound travels. Children under 18 must be at their registered campsites during quiet hours. Campfires must be out by 12 midnight and socializing needs to move inside. Get some sleep tomorrow is a new day.
- **Check-out Time:** Check-out time is at 11:00 AM. If you wish to extend your stay please notify the office prior to 10 a.m. Late check-outs without Campground approval will be charged \$5.00 / every hour after 11:00 A.M. Early check-in may be available with a small charge not to exceed \$10.00, if site is available.
- **Garbage and Litter:** Place all garbage and litter in the dumpsters provided at the entrance. Do not leave outside for the wild animals that sometimes visit us. They do not have very good table manners nor do they make reservations.
- **Water Conservation:** Help Us Conserve – We Must Haul All Our Water. Washing Vehicles is not allowed. Please help us by reporting leaks on your own site or neighboring sites so that we may fix them.
- **Parking Permits:** Parking pass must be displayed on your dash. Registered campers are responsible for their guests and for ensuring they register with the office and obey all campground policies. All visitors must exit the campground by 9 pm. Guest not registering with the office will be asked to leave. In case of an emergency we are required to know who is at the campground.
- **Extra Vehicles:** One RV plus one vehicle per RV site and one vehicle per Tent/Cabin site. If you would like to park in an adjacent site notify the office and we will be happy to rent it to you. Extra parking areas are available; please check with office for availability and location. Riding of Dirt bikes, Motor Scooters, or ATV's is not allowed on campground property, nor is operation of any vehicle by a person without a valid driver's license.
- **Fires:** Fires are only permitted in the fire rings provided please do not move these. No campfire shall be unattended at any time, extinguish all campfires with water. Do not cut or destroy trees in campground or surrounding areas. Grills are for charcoal use only. If you abuse it you may lose it. Violators will be fined a minimum of \$25.00.
- **Firearms / Fireworks** are not permitted in the Park. We are in the West not the Wild West.
- **Children:** Children's behavior and supervision are the responsibility of an adult or guardian. Children under 8 years of age must be accompanied by a parent while on campground property. Children are nice, well behaved children are better.
- **Swimming Pool:** NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY. Children under 17 are required to be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian. Observe posted rules. Proper swimming attire required regardless of age. NO glass, alcohol in pool area. We do not take these rules lightly and maintain a zero tolerance in the pool area to ensure everyone's safety and well being. Violators will forfeit pool privileges for length of stay. Pool will close immediately upon adverse weather conditions.
- **Restrooms and Showers:** Restrooms are for the exclusive use of our paying guests. We work hard to keep them clean, please notify the office if you see something that requires our attention. Showers are operated by tokens. You may purchase tokens in the office during posted office hours. For washing of dishes or laundry please use the laundry room which is open 24hours.
- **Neighbors:** Please respect the privacy of your neighbors and do not walk across occupied site areas. No clotheslines, hanging laundry, oil changes or major repairs to vehicle allowed. This is an opportunity to make new friends.
- **Sewer Hoses:** All sewer hoses must have elbows and tight fitting connection to prevent leaks. Sewer hoses should not be stuck down the sewer drainpipe. Do not dump grey water on the ground. No one wants a smelly campground.
- **Pets:** We like pets and enjoy their company. All pets must be registered with the Campground office. To ensure that the pets and our other guests enjoy their stay we need your help. No exceptions to these rules. Violators will be asked to leave.
 1. Owners must be attached to pet with leash while walking.
 2. Clean up after your pet on the entire premise.
 3. No unattended pets, do not tie pet outside and leave
 4. No Excessive Barking.
 5. No Pet Fencing outside RV or Campsite.
 6. Use the off leash area for freedom to run
 7. Maximum 2 pets per RV site and 1 per Tent.
 8. Pets must be current on vaccines.

By entering Royal View @ Royal Gorge Campground and/or paying fees, all guests agree to the above rules & conditions. Campers and Guest use all facilities at their own Risk. Guests agree to be responsible for the repair/replacement cost of any damage caused by them or their visitors and may be immediately evicted from the property for violations. Royal View at Royal Gorge Campground and Management are not responsible for accidents, injury or loss of property. No refunds will be given.
